In July 2024, a call for expression of interest for requesting an extension for the PhD thesis presentation deadline with financial coverage was published to the attention of CLOE ESRs.

It was recalled that, according to University of Genoa PhD regulations (D.R. n. 2340 of 27.05.2022), it is possible to request an extension, upon acceptance by the Doctoral Course Board.

Within the framework of the MSCA COFUND CLOE project, funded by the EU with GA No. 101034449 and co-funded by the Compagnia di San Paolo Foundation, it resulted possible to provide (partial) financial coverage for the extension period with a research grant in line with the mobility program.

The available resources for covering potential extensions amount were 490 days.

Since six extension requests, received before the deadline of July 31, 2024, exceeded the available resources, this Commission, composed of the Primary Supervisors of the fourteen active ESRs, evaluated the needs based on the following criteria and determined the actual coverage of the extension:

- Appropriate scientific motivation (theoretical and/or experimental integration needs) of the request of additional months to conclude the PhD project (maximum 1500 characters) (up to 15 points)
- Appropriate organizational motivation (training and/or secondment integration needs) of the request of additional months to conclude the PhD project (maximum 1500 characters) (up to 15 points)

After jointly examining ESRs' requests, the Commission formulated the following score table, leading to resources allocation as reported in the final column:
